The Parish Council is supporting the preparation of a Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) for Great Massingham.

What is an NDP and why do we want one?

NDPs detail a community's vision about the use and development of land. It is the most effective way a parish like ours can protect itself from unwanted development and steer the future in directions more of its choosing. NDPs have real legal force and our Borough Council must consider them when assessing planning applications.

What is involved?

NDPs require much prior consultation, preparation and engagement with a wide cross-section of the village. The procedures are highly democratic, typically take 1 or 2 years to complete and end with a confirming referendum.
